### **Minutes of the Previous Meeting**

The Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting on the 14 September 2022 had been previously circulated to Parish Councillors. The Minutes were accepted as a true record.

### **Reports from Councillors.**

District Councillor Charlie Maynard again brought the Council up to date with his efforts to restore the water to the Northmoor Brook. His work is ongoing.

Charlie has also attended WODC's Climate & Environmental Control Scrutiny Committee to listen to a report from Thames Water. From that meeting Charlie has further meetings that are ongoing.

Potholes were an item that Charlie raised at the last meeting. He is looking for a village road steward for Northmoor to mark and report potholes on Northmoor's roads.

Parish Councillor Carrie Berry reported on the community conversation meetings on 22nd Sept in the village hall to allow villagers to chat about the needs and interests of our community. The meeting was well attended, and useful ideas came from it.

The Clerk, Michael Ryan, reported that he had met with Bill Oddy of Ubico to discuss the issues of dog waste bins. Most issues were resolved except for the bin on the towpath at Bablockhythe. Bill will be contacting the director of Green Wood Parks to resolve.

The Clerk also reported that Fionna Florey was gathering a group together to discuss updating the Play Park.

**Item 6. Finance.**

Councillors approved the payments that had been made to: -  
 Christ Church £39.50, the six-monthly rent for the allotments  
 Ubico £23.15 for emptying dog waste bin at Bablock Road.

**Item 7. Planning.**

**22/02371/S73.** Request to change conditions relating to Planning Consents 15/04506/S73 and 15/00320/FUL Mr McGovern, Park Farm Place. These two Applications relate to unfinished work at the far end of this development. This Council objected to the removal of works that should have been completed when the housing was complete. *Clerk to write*

**22/02661/S73** Mrs Stapleton, Cokethorpe School. A request to change the conditions for the groups using the boathouse.

This Council at its consideration of the original Application had reservations that in part were answered by Condition 8 restricting the boat house to be used for educational purposes and would not wish to see this condition removed. *Clerk to write*
